## Short description of the organisation

MusiQuE - Music Quality Enhancement is an external evaluation organisation dedicated to assisting higher music education institutions (conservatoires, music universities and academies, etc.) in constantly enhancing quality. # Description of the internship

- MusiQuE's communication activities (including through newsletters and websites)
- The compilation of feedback questionnaires from institutions/programmes reviewed and from reviewers
- The preparation and follow-up of MusiQuE Board meetings (including practical organisation, preparation of documents and annexes before and after the meetings, writing meeting minutes)
- MusiQuE's financial and administrative day-to-day tasks

### **Required profile**

This internship is highly suitable for students in cultural management courses, European studies, communication studies, social studies, or related humanities programmes, wanting to have experience in working in a cultural organisation on European level and in working with European funding programmes in education and culture.
